You may send your payment to P.O. Box 546, Westfield, IN 46074.


Cash, check or money orders are


Potholes: If you see any, contact Westfield Public Works at 896-5452 so they can be corrected. They have already been out to repair minor cracks in the street. They will be able to make more repairs as the weather

Pond Maintenance: Please be diligent in requesting to your children that they are always careful when playing the HOA, if streets are not near the pond.

Just as the signage states, there is no fishing, swimming, boating, or ice skating on the pond. To keep our pond looking nice. please keep children from throwing the rip rap rock or other objects into the pond.

Snow Removal: Is a service provided by the City of Westfield and not plowed you may call Public Works at 896-5452.

Please remember our young neighbors! Just a reminder our neighborhood speed limit is only 20 mph!



Property Reminders

Post lights: Please be sure that your yard post light is working. If your post is in need of a new bulb or repairs, please take care of this on one of our first warm days.

Lighting is important to the safety of our community and keeping our neighborhood looking nice.

Lawn Maintenance: Fair weather will be here before we know it! Please remember to keep weeds at bay by treating your lawn as necessary. Please keep lawns mowed to an appropriate level.

There are foreclosures in our neighborhood. If you see a house that is unoccupied and the property is not being maintained, please contact the HOA so the correct bank in ownership of the property can be notified.

Parked Vehicles: Please ensure that you are not blocking a fire hydrant or mailbox and are not facing the wrong direction or parked too close to stop signs or bus stops. These parked cars can create very dangerous conditions for our neighborhood.

Trash Bins: Please store bins out of sight, on the side of your house, in your garage or backyard for a cleaner streetscape.

The City of Westfield is marking a bike loop route around our city. The streets of our neighborhood have been selected for part of this path.


The signage and routes should be posted in the Spring of 2013.
